

Who can take the test: Future students of UTS Science who want to commence study in Autumn 2022 (commences on 20 February 2023), but feel their HSC results might not reflect their scientific potential. Those students who have not completed the assessment in the last 12 months. Future students should have a current application lodged with the Universities Admission Centre (UAC) and chose the UTS Science's course as their first preference.

Our Jumbunna Pathways Program into University is open to recent-school leavers (with or without an ATAR); non-school leavers; people with TAFE, College or previous University qualifications. The Jumbunna Pathways Program offers Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students an opportunity to enter higher education based on education, previous life and work experience.

UTS Women In Engineering, IT, Construction 10 Adjustment Points

If you're female and have applied for selected engineering, information technology or construction project management courses, you're eligible to receive 10 adjustment points. These adjustment points are automatically applied (no additional application required) and contribute to your selection rank. See the full range of degrees here:

UTS – Support your UAC application with the Engineering and IT Questionnaire

If you fall short of the selection rank requirement by one to three points, we'll still consider your application if you submit the Engineering and IT Questionnaire and demonstrate a strong motivation to study engineering or IT.

You achieved a minimum selection rank of 75. This selection rank cut-off includes your raw ATAR and adjustment factors.

You've listed UTS Engineering or IT as your first preference in UAC. Download this template and input your responses to these three questions where asked:

Why are you interested in studying at UTS and what do you expect to gain from your experience in the Faculty of Engineering and IT?

Which of your personal attributes and skills will assist you most in your future career?

Describe something you have created or designed and how it is related to your preferred course.

UTS – Bachelor of Information Technology (BIT) Co-operative Scholarship

Please note: applications Close 4 September 2022.

Interviews will be held on the 28 September 2022.

The BIT is a highly competitive course – it's been designed with future leaders in mind. To get in, you'll need to demonstrate how you stand out from the crowd.

Successful students generally achieve a Selection Rank of 88–99.95; however, your ATAR is just one component of your application.

The interview is all about showing us who you are. You'll need to demonstrate that you're highly motivated and have what it takes to progress to a senior management career.

ACU – Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Master of Teaching (Secondary)

Applications for Semester 1 2023 will open in August 2022

Four-and-a-half years full-time

This is a double degree for students who wish to pursue a multidisciplinary Bachelor of Arts centred in key texts of the Western intellectual tradition, followed by a Master of Teaching (Secondary) enabling them to become fully qualified secondary teachers in two teaching areas including English. Scholarships valued at \$135,000 (\$30,000 per year) are available to high-achieving Australian citizens or permanent residents.

This course is offered at our North Sydney Campus. The Master of Teaching (Secondary) units can be undertaken at the Strathfield, Melbourne or Brisbane campuses, or online.

Reminder Next Deadline Soon – UNE and UON Joint Medical Program

To apply to the Joint Medical Program in 2023, you must complete the following three steps.

How to apply Step 1 – Should be done earlier by 17 May 2022.

Register with the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT ANZ) office and attend a UCAT ANZ session at a nominated test site. Fees apply. Registration closes 17 May 2022. UCAT ANZ testing begins 1 July and concludes 12 August 2022. All enquiries concerning UCAT ANZ should be directed to the UCAT ANZ office.

Final bookings will be accepted until Monday 31 May at 11:59pm AEST and will incur the late fee of AUD \$85.

Step 2: Apply online to the Joint Medical Program – Applications close on 30 September 2022

Applications will open in August. You will have the opportunity to review your application after it has been submitted. For details and instructions on how to apply, please download the online application instructions. Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Step 3: Apply through UAC by 30 September 2022

Submit your early bird application through the Universities Admission Centre (UAC) by 30 September 2022. Late applications may be accepted by UAC, but late fees apply.

You must include Joint Medical Program at the University of Newcastle/University of New England among your preferences. You can't change your preferences to add this program after 1 December 2022.

The Joint Medical Program is included in the Educational Access Scheme. Through the Educational Access Scheme (EAS) you can get up to four additional adjustment points if you have experienced educational or other disadvantage. For more information about the EAS see [here](#).



You will need to advise us if you believe you are eligible under the Domestic and Violence Fee-Free Scholarship criteria.

The Fee-Free scholarship covers the student course fee you would normally pay.

The NSW Government's new Smart and Skilled Fee-Free Scholarships mean that students can get the skills they need to get the job they want and their course fees will be covered.

Young people (aged 15-30) who meet the Smart and Skilled Fee-Free Scholarship criteria are eligible for a government subsidy which covers their Smart and Skilled course fee.
