At the end of 2018, Year 9 students and their families will be invited to attend the 2018 Graduation Assembly. At this time students will be presented with a certificate to mark the completion of their studies at the Umina Campus. This certificate is graded and is based on our Core School Values.

To foster the achievement of personal bests, each student will be encouraged to undertake a self-monitoring process. At least once a term students will be given the opportunity to assess their progress against a checklist of expectations that reflect our core values of RESPECT, COMMITMENT and RELATIONSHIPS. Periodic check-ins with their Team Leaders will facilitate constructive discussions and enable students to make positive changes to their learning. Ongoing support from parents will ensure that students strive to do their best throughout the year.

Below is an explanation of the certificate gradings and over the page is an example of the checklist used for monitoring student progress throughout the year. We look forward to positive student participation, and parental support and input throughout the year.

Certificates are awarded as follows:

PLATINUM - demonstrates excellence in core values.

The student has scored 66 - 70 points and attained Platinum through the PBL system.

GOLD - demonstrates diligence in core values.

The student has scored 60 - 65 points and attained Gold through the PBL system.

SILVER - demonstrates proficiency in core values.

The student has scored 50 - 59 points and attained Silver through the PBL system.

BRONZE - demonstrates competence in core values.

The student has scored 30 - 49 points and attained Bronze through the PBL system.

STATEMENT OF ATTAINMENT - basic accomplishment.

The student has scored 16 - 29 points. Count on the PBL may vary.

LETTER OF COMPLETION – Confirmation of enrolment at BWSC.

The student has scored 0 - 15 points. Count on the PBL may vary.
