2018 SCHOOL VACCINATION PROGRAM

In 2018 students in Years 7, 8, 10 and 11 will be offered the following vaccinations:-

Year 7

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) and Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis (Whooping Cough)

Year 8

HPV dose 2 (catch up program for 2017 Year 7 students who commenced the HPV vaccination at school but did not complete the course)

Years 10 and 11

One dose of Meningococcal ACWY vaccination

Your school's clinics have been scheduled as follows:-

FIRST VISIT:

Tuesday 20 and Wednesday 21 March 2018

Year 7

HPV Dose 1 and/or Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis vaccinations

Year 8

HPV Dose 2 catch up vaccination

SECOND VISIT:

Tuesday 25 and Wednesday 26 September 2018

Year 7

HPV Dose 2 vaccination, plus catch up HPV Dose 1 and/or

Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis vaccinations

Year 8

HPV Dose 2 catch up vaccination (for students absent at previous

visit)

All consent forms and notes will be collected and retained by the immunisation team after each visit.

2017 Year 7 students requiring catch up HPV vaccination in 2018. Their consent form has been retained by the immunisation team and the names of these students will be emailed to the school coordinator prior to the first school clinic.

If a student in Year 7 or 8 is absent on the day of the clinic the consent form will be retained by the immunisation team and written advice regarding catch up options will be sent to the parent/guardian.

All consenting vaccination forms are to be completed and signed (in **BLUE** or **BLACK** pen). No vaccine will be given unless there is a signed consent by the parent/guardian.

Withdrawal of Consent: If a parent contacts the school to withdraw consent for the program please follow the protocol accompanying this information. **NB**: This is only necessary if the parent has previously returned a completed consent form.
